Television

With major TV partners behind them, the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix ensures that tennis fans at home will also get their money's worth. Most matches in the Porsche Arena will be shown live. Internationally, the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix will be broadcast in over 100 countries.

"Aces for Charity" campaign

As a part of the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix's societal commitment, Porsche traditionally supports the work of charitable organisations through the "Aces for Charity" fundraiser. The sports car manufacturer will once again this year donate 100 euro for each ace struck. The donation, which will be divided up equally between the "Stuttgarter Kinderstiftung" and the "Stiftung Agapedia" foundations, will go towards supporting centres and projects for children in Stuttgart and the surrounding region. At the 2025 Porsche Tennis Grand Prix, 199 aces were served up to and including the final. Porsche rounded up the donation amount to 30,000 euros.

First Porsche Tennis Grand Prix

First played in 1978, it is Europe's oldest women's indoor tournament. The first winner was the American Tracy Austin who went on to win the next three Grand Prix.

The most successful players

With six wins to her name, Martina Navratilova (USA) is the most successful player in the history of the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix. Behind her are Tracy Austin (USA) and Martina Hingis (SUI) on four wins apiece, Maria Sharapova (RUS) and Lindsay Davenport (USA) with three wins and Anke Huber (GER),

Kim Clijsters (BEL), Justine Henin (BEL), Porsche Brand Ambassador Angelique Kerber (GER) and Porsche Friend Iga Swiatek, who have each won twice.

German winners

Four German players have managed to win the tournament to date: Anke Huber (1991 and 1994), Julia Görges (2011), Angelique Kerber (2015 and 2016) and Laura Siegemund (2017).

Men's tournament

The only Porsche Tennis Grand Prix for men was held in 1979. Two Porsche Grand Prix took place that year. For the record: The Pole Wojtek Fibak beat the Argentine Guillermo Vilas in the final and won a Porsche 928.
